



On March 1, 2011, the Massachusetts Clean Energy Center (MassCEC) will be hosting a Small Wind Stakeholder Forum for small wind installers and stakeholders in the Commonwealth. This roundtable is intended to provide informational resources regarding MassCEC's small wind rebate program and to serve as a forum for discussing the state of the small wind industry in Massachusetts. This meeting will be solely focused on small wind in Massachusetts: wind turbines under 100 kW that produce electricity primarily for on-site consumption.

The agenda for the Small Wind Stakeholder Forum will include:

- A review of MassCEC's Commonwealth Wind Micro Wind Program, including recent program updates and future plans
- A review of basic wind resource analysis
- A tutorial on the use of the Commonwealth Wind Evaluation and Siting Tool (CWEST)
- An open forum for discussing the state of the Massachusetts small wind industry

The forum is open to the public, but will be specifically geared towards installers and stakeholders in the Massachusetts small wind industry. Participants are strongly encouraged to attend in person. However, a conference line will be made available if you cannot attend in person.

The forum will be held in Boston at the Department of Energy Resources (DOER) Conference Room B, located at 100 Cambridge St. The meeting will begin from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Please RSVP to microwind@masscec.com by February 24.
